NOTICE IS GIVEN that we are applying to the Consistory Court of the diocese for permission to carry out the following:

Refurbishment of the church tower clock including:

1. Overhaul of dial motion works and hands involving removal of hands and 3 sets of dial motion works and transporting all parts to the workshop. Dismantling of dial motion works, cleaning, checking the bearings for wear, polishing all working surfaces, painting, re-greasing and reassembling. Cleaning and suitable painting of the hands, finishing in black gloss. Washing of dials, refitting of dial motion works and hands, and synchronising with each other
2. Overhaul of the movement, strike and quarter chime hammers, involving dismantling of the complete movement, existing auto-winding system and supporting framework and lowering to ground level, and removal of the strike and quarter hammers. (Existing auto-winding system to first be disconnected from electrical supply before dismantling). Transporting of all parts to the workshop, possibly leaving the old auto-wind motors on site. Washing and cleaning of the complete movement, checking all bearings and pinions and relining any worn bearings. Polishing of all working surfaces, oiling and reassembling. Dismantling of the strike hammer and quarter chime hammers, washing, cleaning and blasting to remove any corrosion, painting, checking the bearings and pivots for wear, polishing, re-greasing and reassembling. Return to site and refitting of the movement and hammers. Dismantling and cleaning of the connecting cranks, replacing the hammer connecting wire with stainless steel wire and adjusting the hammers so they operate on the bells correctly, and synchronizing the movement with the dials.
3. Manufacture of three epicyclic automatic winding units and three split sprockets to fit barrel arbors of the quarter, striking and time trains. Onsite fitting of sprockets to barrel arbors and installation of automatic winding units and hanging of weights. Provision of a suitable electrical supply in the form of 3 x 13 amp sockets for the new autowinder units
4. Manufacture and installation of autoregulator system, and provision of additional electrical sockets as required
5. Existing night silencer system to be disconnected from electrical supply before dismantling. Manufacture and installation of replacement night silencer system including two linear actuator pull off units, brackets and time controller. Addition of electrical sockets and fused spur as required

A letter of objection must include your name and address and state whether you live in the parish and/or your name is entered on the church electoral roll of the parish or any other basis on which you have an interest in the matter.**

### **Directions to petitioner**

You must display this public notice (or a copy of it) for a continuous period of not less than 28 days, not counting the day on which it was put up or the day on which it is taken down, (or for such other period as the Court may direct and subject to any special directions of the registrar) in each of the following places:

1. on a notice board or in some other prominent position inside the church; and
2. on a notice board outside the church or in some other prominent position (whether on the outside of the church door or elsewhere) so that it can be read by the public.
